This fuel is BP Ultimate. RaceFuels uses different collection and storage techniques vs normal service stations. RaceFuels collects 98 RON fuel directly from the terminal, with the benefit being that it is fresh, uncontaminated fuel ready for competition. RaceFuels actively tests and checks our fuel for quality. RaceFuels 98 RON is dyed red for identification.

RaceFuels supplies this same fuel to Porsche Carrera Cup.

This fuel is BP Racing E-85. This fuel is batch tested to ensure 85% ethanol plus 15% 98RON, this is a strict requirement for RaceFuels supplied E-85. As per the 98 RON RaceFuels uses different collection and storage techniques compared with normal service stations. The Supercars championship requires a consistent, high quality E-85 fuel. RaceFuels E85 is dyed green for identification.

RaceFuels supplies this same fuel to the Supercars Championship.



This fuel is imported into Australia from France, this unleaded racing fuel has high octane (102.5 - 104.5 RON) and 3% oxygen to offer both power and protection. This fuel meets the new CAMS fifth category criteria as an AVGAS alternative fuel. This fuel has lubricity additive to protect older style engines and we are witnessing excellent power gains in most engines.

RaceFuels supplies this same fuel to Touring Car Masters.



This fuel is imported into Australia from France as an FIA compliant 102 RON unleaded racing fuel offering both power and protection to competition engines. Blended under the strict controls of the FIA regulations, Elf LMS is triple refined at a dedicated Motorsport refinery ensuring consistent, high quality racing fuel.

RaceFuels supplies this same fuel to the Australian GT Championship.
